THE ART OF NEIGHBORING

Start Here: [Who Is My Neighbor?](#) | [Luke 10:25-37](#) | June 7, 2026

Theme: Your neighbor is not a concept to define; your neighbor is a person to become.

Points 1-3 (from the May 24 intro)

1. The expert wanted to limit responsibility. Jesus expands it.
2. Neighboring crosses inconvenience, bias, and boundaries.
3. Love is defined by action, not intention.

POINT 4: The Real Question Behind the Question

Luke 10:29 But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

Key Truth: Self-justification is the real issue. If I can define "neighbor," I can define my limits.

The question "Who is my neighbor?" is sometimes just:

POINT 5: Jesus Shifts the Question from "Who Qualifies?" to "Who Are You Becoming?"

Luke 10:36 "Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?"

Key Truth: Jesus doesn't answer the question asked. He answers the question needed.

POINT 6: The Story Forces You to Locate Yourself

Key Truth: Jesus makes sure we see we've been all three at different times.

Which role are you in most right now?

The Wounded Man — helpless, needing someone to stop

The Priest / Levite — I saw it, I had reasons, I kept moving

The Samaritan — I stopped. It cost me. I did it anyway.

POINT 7: Love Is Costly Interruption, Not Convenient Intention

Key Truth: Biblical love is not measured by how much you care. It's measured by what it costs you to obey when it's inconvenient.
